Steps to Becoming a CNM Running Start Dual Credit Student

Here's how:

1. Go to cnm.edu/dualcredit. Fill out the free online application. Be sure to select “Dual Credit” as your application type and you won’t be charged for tuition. You will receive a student ID number at the end of the process or one will be emailed to your personal email address.
2. Submit the required agreement form at any CNM Admissions Office within five business days or email it to admissions@cnm.edu. Visit cnm.edu/dcagreement.

Before registering:

3. Complete the New Student Orientation. Find out more at cnm.edu/nso. *Dual Credit students must complete the online orientation.*
4. Set up your **myCNM** account at cnm.edu. Click on **myCNM**.
5. It is recommended that you meet with a CNM Dual Credit Academic Coach. Please call 224-3186.

Register for class:

6. Log into **myCNM** (cnm.edu).
7. Click on the “Registration” tab.
8. Under “Registration Tools,” click on “Register for Classes.”
9. Select your appropriate term and click “Continue.”
10. Click on the “Enter CRNs” tab, then enter the appropriate CRN and click “Add to Summary,” then click “Submit” on the bottom right.

Obtain Your Class Schedule:

11. On the “Registration” tab, click on “Your Class Schedule” to confirm your schedule of classes and to view the campus and classroom location along with the days and times of the class.
